DECEMBER'S COMMUNION OFFERING

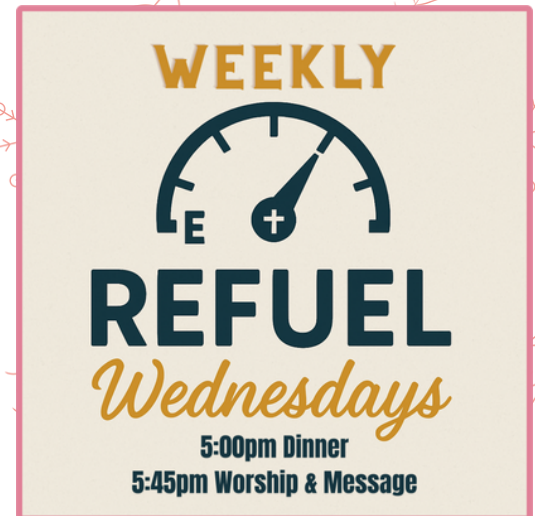

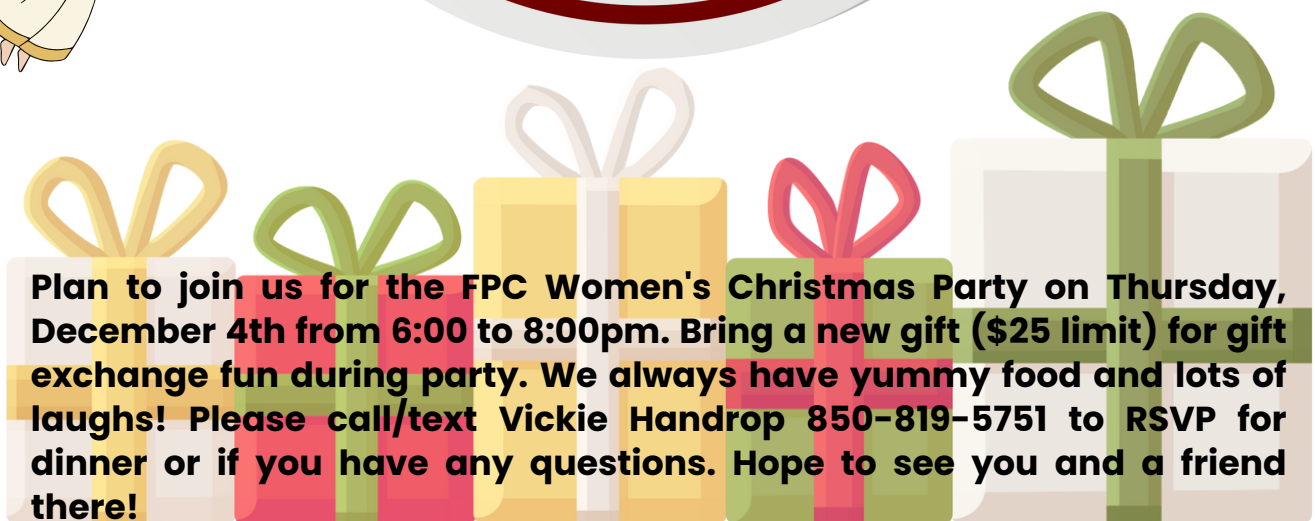
